Introductory provisions

1. Skal Biocontrole is the independent organization that monitors the entire organic chain in the Netherlands. Skal is dedicated to proving the reliability of organic products for consumers through monitoring, registration, and certification.
2. As of 1 January 2022, this includes the following four target groups:
 - Sales to consumers (B2C);
B2C includes: online stores that sell directly to consumers and/or businesses, head offices of all companies affiliated to it in any way, such as affiliated shops and/or other retail outlets, and/or franchise companies and/or distribution centers, independent shops and market stalls;
 - Companies under supervision arrangement Low;
 - Companies under supervision arrangement Normal;
 - Companies under supervision arrangement High.

In case the target group is NOT B2C, an operator will be classified in the year of notification in the supervision arrangement Normal.

The overview on the following page shows the amounts and rates applicable to each target group.

3. On basis of the situation as of 1 January and on the basis of certain criteria, companies (with the exception of companies in the B2C target group) are classified in the supervision arrangement Low, Normal, or High. This risk classification is further explained in the Regulations for Certification and Supervision (R11).
4. When the inspection is discontinued because the inspector cannot properly perform the inspection, the costs of the discontinued inspection will be borne by the operator. This applies to all types of inspections. The inspection will then be carried out again at another time. These costs are also for the operator's account.
5. Please refer to the Skal Contribution Regulations, R15, for the general terms and conditions for financial obligations.
6. Processing and Trading companies include the manufacturing, importing, trading and storage thereof.
7. All amounts are exclusive of VAT.
8. This Rate Sheet replaces all previous versions of the Skal Rate Sheet.
9. The amount of the established fees are presented to and approved by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries, Food Security and Nature.
10. Adjustments to these regulations take effect following approval by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries, Food Security and Nature. Skal may adjust its fees annually.

1 Registration fee and the entrance examination

An operator pays a one-off fee upon registration:

1. The registration fee (see par. 1.1);
2. The costs for the entrance examination (see par. 1.2);
3. Any applicable surcharge (see par. 1.3 and par. 6);
4. In addition, the operator annually pays, therefore also in the first year, in proportion to the annual fee (see par. 2) and in proportion to the supervisory fee (see par. 4) and in full the certification fee (see par. 3).

1.1 Application fee/registration fee

This concerns a payment for the evaluation of the application/registration and the creation of a digital file.

1.2 Entrance examination

The costs for the entrance examination consist of the inspection time. The inspection costs are calculated based on the time spent.

1.3 Surcharges to the registration fee and entrance examination

An operator who chooses the urgent procedure (visit of an inspector within 10 working days) pays the surcharge to the registration fee per location.	€ 450,00
Surcharge in case the requested data were inadequate and have to be forwarded at a later stage. This is an extra charge for reviewing the data which have been forwarded to the Skal office at a later stage.	€ 127,00

2 Annual fee

The annual fee applies per calendar year. Operators who are registered for a part of the year pay a registration fee proportionate to the time of their application. Skal applies different charges for the various target groups. These definitions have been established in Article 3 of the Skal Regulations for Certification and Supervision (R11).

Category "regular annual fee"

This fee applies to operators who do not fall under the category "small bio-company" and "manure intermediary".

Category "small bio-company"

Small biological companies are operators that apply to the following conditions:

- The biological turnover of the previous financial year (2024) was verifiable € 80.000,00 or lower, and:
- The company is fully biological, there are no activities involving conventional products.

Smaller biological companies must annually submit a declaration within the set deadline.

No annual fee will be charged to small biological companies (with the exception of B2C)

Category "manure intermediary"

Operators who meet the requirements of the category 'manure intermediary' (storage and if necessary processing of biological manure). No entrance examination is carried out at these operators, only a periodic inspection. These operators cannot apply for an urgent procedure.

The following annual contribution per calendar year applies:

3 Certification fee

The certification fee applies per year. The certification fee covers the indirect costs of certification during the validity period of the certificate. Operators who sign up during the year pay the entire certification fee. In the event of withdrawal there will be no refund for the remaining period of the calendar year. For the different target groups the contributions are as follows:

B2C per location of (independent) shops, retail outlets, market stalls and online shops	€ 201,00

Online shops that are only registered, are exempt from paying the certification fee.

No certification fee will be charged to small biological companies (with the exception of B2C).

4 Supervisory fee

The supervisory fee applies per calendar year. This supervisory fee covers the costs of supervising the operators affiliated with Skal. Operators who are registered for only a part of the year pay a pro rata for the period of registration.

For the various target groups the contribution is as follows:

No supervisory fee will be charged to small biological companies (with the exception of B2C).

5 Periodic inspection

The annual inspection costs consist of a charge for the duration of the inspection. The inspection duration is calculated based on the time spent, with a minimum of one hour. This means that the annual inspection cost will always amount to at least € 127,00. In case the inspection lasts longer than one hour, Skal will charge the extra time at € 127,00 per hour.

The annual inspection costs will be charged by Skal per location. The guiding principle is that each location undergoes one inspection per year.

In case the inspection needs to be aborted within one hour, because the inspector is unable to execute the inspection, only a charge of € 254,00 will apply. That rate corresponds to the rate for an inspection cancelled by the operator within 14 days of the planned inspection date (see par. 6 Additional fees). If the inspector needs to abort the inspection one hour after the start of the inspection, because the inspection cannot be executed, an amount of € 254,00 plus the inspection time will be charged.

Based on the Bio-regulations Skal can divide operators into supervision arrangement High, Normal or Low. The operators in supervision arrangement Low are audited once in 24 months and pay the audit fees only in the year the actual inspection takes place. Operators in supervision arrangement High are subject to an additional mandatory paid inspection. The risk classification of the operators is further described in the Certification and Supervision regulations (R11), which can be found on the Skal website.

<i>Additional inspection at the initiative of Skal or per request of a (potential) operator</i> The costs consist of the costs for the inspection time with a minimum of one hour.	€ 127,00
